Please note - 2003 Hourly rate of \$10 for labor, \$20 for running chainsaw, \$30 for running brush hog

April 13 - Upton State Forest, Upton MA.

Trimming back on some trails. Cleaning and trimming around headquarters area, brush burning.

60 hours Value of work \$720.00

April 18 - Upton State Forest, Upton MA

Cutting and brushing back Grouse Trail. 10 hours. Value of work \$100.00

April 19 - Mendon open space property, Mendon MA

Mapping trails with GPS. 18 hours. Value of work \$360.00

April 27 - Earth Day Ride: Upton State Forest, Upton MA

17 riders picked up 351 items of trash. 25.5 hours Value of work \$255.00

May 17 - Southern New England Trunkline Trail, Douglas MA

Between Martin Rd. & Monroe Street. Cutting and brushing back. 17.25 hours Value of work \$215.75

May 18 - Callahan State Park, Framingham MA

Clearing trail & putting up trail signs. 12.5 hours Value of work \$125.00

June 7 - West Hill Dam, Uxbridge MA

Trimming for horse height clearance, clean out water bars, brushing back.

28 hours Value of work \$320.00

Summer - Bridge for Mill Pond Trail, Hubbardston MA

BSTRA letter of support helped Hubbardston open space committee get a grant for an Americorps crew (6 people) that worked 5 days to build new trail and bridge. BSTRA members also worked on bridge/trail project for a total of 57 hours. BSTRA donated \$208.85 to pay for the lumber to construct the bridge. Total of 297 hours for all plus \$208.85 for materials gives us \$3,178.85 put in on this project.

Total: \$5,674.40 is the grand total worth of work we put back into trails for 2003!!!
