

BSTRA 2006 TRAILS REPORT

Labor rates as follows:

Hourly work \$17.05, mowing & GPS \$25, chainsaw/brushcutter \$30/hr and brush hog work at \$50/hr.

March 18th & 25th:	BSTRA donated \$875 towards gravel and members contributed 24 hours of labor over the two work days to help improve trails owned by the Grafton Land Trust, Grafton MA. This gives us a value of \$1,284.20
March 25th:	4 hours flagging out new re-route of a section of trail on the Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon MA. Value of \$68.20
April 1st:	24 hours to cut out the flagged section of the new re-route and close the old section at Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon MA. Value of \$435.10 Plus \$20.21 to feed workers.
April 2nd:	103 hours to do cutting and brushing back on the trails and parking area of the Upton State Forest in Upton MA. This work day had BSTRA members, boy scouts, girl scouts, Friends of the Upton State Forest and New England Mountain Bike Association members. Value of \$1,795.
April 8th:	9.75 hours to cut and brush back a half mile section of the Southern New England Trunkline Trail in Douglas. Morse Pond to the Grand Trunk. Value of \$192.14 Plus \$17.54 to feed workers.
April 15th:	7 hours of trail work at Weston Forest in Middleboro, MA. Value of \$119.35
April 22nd:	28 hours to clear out water bars, brushing back and cleaning up some downed trees at West Hill Dam in Uxbridge MA. Value of \$529.20
April 30th:	Earth Day ride at Upton State Forest, Upton MA. 26 riders picking up trash on the trails and roads. 39 hours for a value of \$664.95
June 22nd:	8 hours cutting and brushing back trails at Buck Hill, RI. Value of \$136.40
July 7th:	6 hours cutting and brushing back trails at Buck Hill, RI. Value of \$102.30
July 30th:	28.5 hours to brush hog fields & trails and pick up trash at Lake Dennison in Winchendon MA. Value of \$650.67
Aug. 10th:	3.5 hours to brush hog Southern New England Trunkline Trail between Yew St. and Rt. 96 in Douglas. Value of \$175.
Aug. 13th:	3.5 hours to brush hog Southern New England Trunkline Trail in Douglas between Yew St. and Martin St. Cutting and brushing back at Depot St. 6 hours. Value of \$277.30
Aug. 14th:	5.75 hours to brush hog Southern New England Trunkline Trail from Martin St. halfway to West St. in Uxbridge MA. Value of \$287.50
Aug. 17th:	6 hours putting up permanent trail markers up at Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon MA. Value of \$102.30
Aug. 27th:	Trail trimming on the Southern New England Trunkline Trail in Douglas MA. 2 hours for a value of \$34.10
Summer:	Dorothy Frances Rice Sanctuary Peru MA. 4 hours chain saw work, 6.5 hours sign painting, 45.5 hours of trail work and 29.5 hours of mowing. Value of \$1,744.09
Summer:	Peru State Forest, Peru MA 10 hours of trail work. Value of \$170.50
Summer:	10 hours of trail clearing at Norfolk Town Forest in Norfolk MA. Value of \$170.50
Sept. 13th:	GPS trails at Weston Town Forest Middleboro MA. 4 hours for a value of \$100.

Sept. 23rd: National Public Lands Day trail maintenance at Upton State Forest, Upton MA.
12 hours for a value of \$204.60

Oct. 22nd: Wompatuck Trail Work Day with NEMBA in Hingham MA. 10 hours for a value of \$170.50

Dec. 27th: 2.5 hours of trail clearing and clean Wallis St. parking area in Douglas of poop and hay. Value of \$34.10

June/Aug./Sept. Oct.: 4 hours to clean up downed trees and tree trimming pipe line, Hopkinton Rd. crossing to Upton State Forest
and other access roads. Upton MA. Value of \$68.20

Dec. 10th: 3 hours brushing back Park Rd. at Upton State Forest, Upton MA. Value of \$51.15
