

## Bay State Trail Riders Association Trails Report for 2009

We use the Massachusetts value for non-skilled volunteer labor of \$22.46 per hour to figure the value of our donated labor working on trails.

Feb. 21<sup>st</sup>: Myles Standish State Forest Carver MA. Spent 2.5 hours working on the trails for a value of \$56.15

March 1<sup>st</sup>: Myles Standish State Forest Carver MA. Spent 6 hours working on the trails for a value of \$134.76

March 14<sup>th</sup>: Wompatuck Trail Work Day Hingham MA. This trail work day consisted of brushing back on the trails with 10 hours work donated. Value of the work is \$224.60

March 14<sup>th</sup>: Stephans Farm Conservation Land Upton MA. Worked on creating new trails for 4 hours. Value for work is \$89.84

March 15<sup>th</sup>: Douglas State Forest Douglas MA spent 2 hours clearing trails for a value of \$44.92



April 11<sup>th</sup>: West Hill Dam Trail Work Day Uxbridge MA. We cleaned out water bars, brushed back and cleaned up winter debris. We also installed a new water bar. Total of 28 hours for a value of \$628.88. BSTRA paid for lunch \$18.64

April 22<sup>nd</sup>: Clean out water bars at West Hill Dam Uxbridge MA. 1 hour for a value of \$22.46

April 23<sup>rd</sup>: Southern New England Trunkline Trail Douglas MA. 2 hours picking up trash for a value of \$44.92



April 25<sup>th</sup>: Park Serve Day at Douglas State Forest Douglas MA. Cutting and brushing back a section of the Laurel Trail for a total of 70 hours. This has a value of \$1,572.20. BSTRA paid for lunch \$64.46

April 25<sup>th</sup>: Park Serve Day at Upton State Forest Upton MA. General trail maintenance performed with a total of 16 hours. Value of donated labor is \$359.36



April 26<sup>th</sup>: Earth Day Ride at Lake Dennison Winchendon MA. Riders picked up a total of 167.25 pounds of trash. This took the riders a total of 32 hours for a value of \$718.72.

May 14<sup>th</sup>: Natchaug State Forest Eastford CT. Spent 2 hours clearing trails for a value of \$44.92



June 13<sup>th</sup>: Weston Memorial Forest in Middleboro MA. The town forest was logged and they left the trails covered in logging debris. Workers spent 31.5 hours clearing some of the trails for a value of \$707.49.

Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup>: Wompatuck State Forest Hingham MA Trails work day. 3 hours for a value of \$67.38

Sept. Paid \$400 to have parking fields at Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon MA mowed.

Sept. Myles Standish State Forest Carver MA. Donated \$1,000 for cost of "Dingo" machine with cultivator attachment to level out trails. Cutting and brushing back was also done. Approximately 5 miles were done.

Oct. 2<sup>nd</sup>: Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon MA. 6 hours cutting back trails for a value of \$134.76

Oct. 3<sup>rd</sup>: Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon MA. 6 hours cutting back trails for a value of \$134.76

Jan. thru Oct. Dorothy Francis Rice Wildlife Area Peru MA. 179 hours spent doing chain saw work and clearing trails from ice storm damage. Value of \$4,020.34

April thru Aug. Middlefield State Forest Peru MA. 30 hours spent doing chain saw work and clearing trails from ice storm damage. Value of \$673.80

This gives us a grand total of **\$11,163.36** put into trails for 2009. \$9,680.26 was the value of donated labor (431 hours!) and \$1,483.10 in cash.
