Sue Perry's National Trails Day write up.

Today's adventure with the Wonder Pony and his side kick Code Man was the National Trails Day Fundraising Trail Ride with the Bay State Trail Riders Association. It was held at a new venue for the club – the Hazel Grove horse park in Groton MA. It was formerly just called the Groton Fairgrounds; I competed there in the 1990's with Magic in the Nashoba Valley hunter show and Groton Pony Club Two-Phase.

As predicted, the rain arrived just as Emma and I loaded up the horses in Upton at 8:45 this morning. The rain was intermittent during the one-hour drive, becoming more steady as we arrived at the park. We unloaded, finished tacking up (my horses ship groomed and saddled if the journey is an hour or less) and mounted up wearing sweatshirts under our rain coats, just like everyone else.

The trails were REALLY pretty, despite the rain. The billions of rain drops falling on the Nashua River next to the trail were pretty, too, with the foliage on the trees providing some shelter from the rain for us. The trails tended to have roots rather than rocks, like Upton and Douglas, but there were also some smooth-footed areas where we could let the horses trot along. The trail "challenges" were several really deep muddy spots, wooden bridge crossings and step-over fallen trees. BB and Cody were stars, as usual.

Given the rainy conditions, we skipped the optional 3-mile loop in the middle of the ride, completing the rest of the course in one hour and 47 minutes, wet almost all the way through but laughing at it all. Becky, we both really liked the venue and will re-

turn to BSTRA rides held there in the future if we have the dates available.

This ride is a big fundraising one for BSTRA, with money being put toward trail improvement projects. BSTRA provides the volunteer labor and the money purchases materials (lumber for bridges, gravel for muddy areas) and power equipment rentals to do such projects. Some members solicit sponsorship dollars, some pay the extra-large ride registration fee, some donate raffle table items (I gave two autographed Wonder Pony books) and some purchase raffle tickets. Some do all! Emma was raffle #18 and she won four times – got to choose any item still left on the raffle tables. She took a Home Depot gift certificate, a saddle pad, a bag of horse treats and "gave" the last ticket to me to choose something for my horses – a riding-weight fly mask. My number 17 was drawn twice; I chose a blaze-orange neck wrap for BB (Cody already has one that Muz made for Magic years ago) and a rope halter/lead rope combo which I will use as a water-proof bath halter when the current one wears out. BSTRA raised about \$15,200 from all of this!! The sun came out for our drive back to Upton.






