




September 29th: With a small but mighty crew consisting of myself, Valerie Clark, and Cheryl Fitzpatrick, we tackled the installation of 4x4 PT posts for

signs and points of interest along the trail. As we dug holes, our neighbor Alex once again came to the rescue. He used his tractor to move gravel to the bridge and brought more rocks for the sides.

We managed to dig and install three posts and were working on the fourth when Alex surprised us with his skid steer equipped with a post hole auger. Digging holes in New England is no easy task, so this was a delightful surprise! Alex finished the fourth hole, and I guided him to



In total, we put in 14.33 hours of hard work. The combined efforts amounted to 19.83 hours, valued at \$777.14, not including the invaluable donated gravel. **BK**



Mendon Trail Project - Hay Field Trails

The work is now finished on the Hay Field Trails. The signage probably won't be up until next year as the town of Mendon will be suppling and installing the signage.

So for those of you that want to use it now, please stay on the path, it's nice and wide so there is no need to go onto the hay fields.

This project cost \$10,700 with 24.76 hours of project

oversite and work worth \$970.34

As you can see by the map below, there is plenty of room to park trailers in the field that is circled in red. The new hay field trails are in green and the red line is the old field cart road to access the new trail. Once you are back onto Inman Hill Road, just follow it back to where you are parked (the blue dotted line).

This project added 1.2 miles of new trails at Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area. **BK**



After about 1/2 mile, take the first paved right onto Alm Road. If you pass the Speedway, you've gone too far. Follow Alm Road to the end. Take a left onto Baker Road. There will be a BSTRA sign to direct you to the left turn into the field. For GPS use: 165 Baker Road Thompson, CT. That will get you close. Watch for signs!

If you're coming from the Douglas end of East Thompson Road, please swing wide when you are taking that left onto Alm Road so you don't have any issues with your trailer.



Rhode Island regulations require all other users of State Management Areas and designated undeveloped State Parks, including but not limited to: hikers, bikers, and horseback riders are required to wear two hundred (200) square inches of solid daylight fluorescent orange from the second Saturday in September to the last day of February (September 14, 2024 - February 28, 2025) and the third Saturday in April to the last day in May, annually (April 19, 2025 - May 31, 2025). During the shotgun deer season, five hundred (500) square inches are required to be worn

by all users.




