What Did We Do in 2024?

2024 was a fantastic year for BSTRA, marked by exciting events, successful fundraising, and significant contributions to our beloved trails.

We organized 13 rides, attracting 487 enthusiastic riders. The tack sale, trailer safety clinic, and two campouts added to the fun and camaraderie.

Our fundraising efforts were exceptional, generating a remarkable \$18,579.76. Here's how we put those funds to good use:

•Wynham Land Trust: Donated \$10,500 to preserve land open to horseback riding.

•Mass Parks for All: Contributed \$500 to advocate for our forests and parks.

•Friends of Upton State Forest: Donated \$240.30 for future trail improvemen ts.

•Hubbbarston Mt. Jefferson: Contributed \$1,500 for bridge and trail improve ments.

•Grafton: Provided geotextile material for horse-safe bridges.

On our property, we officially opened a 1/2 mile connector trail, including a 0.2mile loop, from the Southern New England Trunkline Trail to the trail system behi nd Douglas schools. This project involved 166.89 volunteer hours, cash expenses o f \$13,310, and donated equipment and materials worth \$2,100, totaling \$22,202. The ribbon-cutting ceremony in December was a proud moment for all involved.

At Inman Hill Wildlife Conservation Area in Mendon, MA, we created 1.2 miles of new trails around the hay fields. This project required 24.76 volunteer hours and \$10,700 in cash expenses, totaling \$11,708.

We also dedicated 162.09 volunteer hours to trail work in Douglas, Upton, Oxford, Thompson, CT, and Escoheag, RI, valued at \$6,598.

In total, we invested a grand sum of \$52,508 into our trails in 2024!

Here's a breakdown of our volunteer hours:

• Events: 649.97 hours



- Fundraising: 84.9 hours
- **Meetings:** 71.24 hours including attending various public hearing and collaborating with organization to represent our interests in horseback riding.
- Trail Projects: 34.25 hours
- Trail Work: 319.49 hours
- Writing: 184.06 hours for newsletters, public hearing comments, grants and letters about trails.

A total of 72 volunteers contributed an impressive 1,426.92 hours. This includes 48 BSTRA members who contributed 1,343.91 hours and 24 non-members who contributed 83.01 hours. The total value of these contributed hours is an astounding \$58,461.

We are incredibly grateful for the dedication and hard work of our volunteers. Here's to another amazing year ahead! **BK**

bility insurance. This will save us from having to submit collected fees and member's information.


Once you fill out your membership form and pay the membership fees your confirmation window will have the link to go the page to pay for your excess personal liability insurance if you wish to have it.

BSTRA Volunteer Award Program Guidelines

When you volunteer your time to help BSTRA, you earn points towards year end awards. If you are involved in an activity that is not listed here, please check with the BSTRA Board of Directors. Also note that the Board of Directors do not receive compensation or volunteer hours for time served related to their positions as officers/directors, except for a complimentary membership. You must be a member in good standing to receive points.

Points are awarded for the following activities.

- 1. Non-BSTRA meetings you attend which are related to trail issues. For example: Town Master Plan meetings, working on a trail or greenway, State Forest Resource Management Plans, Friends of a State Forest or a specific trail. In other words, anything to do with trails allowing horseback riding.
- Time spent representing BSTRA at parades, trade shows, con-2. ferences, etc.
- Time spent preparing for, or cleaning up after, a BSTRA 3. event. For example: marking trails, setting up jumps, taking down markers, setting up tables, making signs, etc.
- 4. Time spent working at a BSTRA event. For example: checking riders in or parking trailers.
- Time spent on writing projects. For example: fundraising 5. letters, grant proposals, press releases, newsletter articles, etc.

- Time spent working on trails. For example: attending BSTRA 6. work days, attending another group's trail work days, verifiable independent work on State or Town trails (include names and phone numbers of person that can verify the work).
- 7. Time spent traveling to meetings, work days, or events, can be counted if travel time is over one hour, one way.

Use the form below to keep track of your hours. At the end of the year, turn it in to Becky Kalagher, 24 Glenn Street, Douglas, MA 01516 or e-mail to bstra@charter.net Forms must be received by January 4th of the new year in order to be eligible. You can also submit your volunteers hours through our website under the Membership tab.


