# Trail Work - Douglas MA

With the weather being a bit more conducive for doing trail work, we started working on the trails behind the Douglas Schools.

Now that we had finished up the BSTRA property trail connector from the SNETT to the town owned property and with permission from the school committee, it was time to move to the next phase.

On Aug. 19th I scoped out and flagged the small connector to make a usable loop for trail users. On the 20th we had Sue & Steve Sanders, Phil Rutledge and myself targeting that newly flagged connector. Section in red on the map at the right.









We did have one patch of mountain laurel and another patch of thick brush that we really had to work to get through. But with the hard work of all four of us, we actually did get it done that morning. All totaled we put in 9 hours worth \$378.

Aug. 21st trail work was Rita Ballou, Joyce Sandvik and myself. The picture of the above map shows the work we did, the trails with the purple slashes on it are the ones that we cut and brushed backed. It was mostly trimming up to the proper height. That was almost .4 of a mile that we did. All totaled we put in 6.75 hours worth \$283.50

I did go back out and post that unsafe bridge with no horses on both ends. The timbers supporting that bridge are old tree logs that are really rotted out.

One can go through the water before the bridge, a bit mucky, but doable.



Wallum Lake Beach Parking Area: 107 Wallum Lake Road, Douglas MA

From Rt. 146 take Douglas/Uxbridge exit. (Rt. 16 West) Go approximately 5½ to 6 miles to blinking overhead light. Go straight onto Southwest Main St. to next 4 way intersection. Take a left onto Wallum Lake Rd. State Forest Headquarters is on the right after stone bridge. Follow signs to parking.

From 395 take Exit 2 (Rt. 16 East). After Webster Sturbridge Family Campground go approximately 2½ to 3 miles to first intersection. Take a right onto Cedar St. At next stop sign go straight ahead. State Forest Headquarters is on the right after stone bridge. Follow signs to parking.
