May 9th Hodges Village Dam Trail Work Day

Five dedicated members volunteered to put in a morning's work on the trails. We weren't entirely sure whether we'd be working in the rain, but luck was on our side just a few sprinkles. Rest assured, none of us melted.

We headed in behind the cemetery and focused our efforts on the High School Hills Trail. Becky Kalagher ran the brush cutter while Bill Knott, Barbara McCumber, Phil Rutledge, and Joyce Sandvik followed behind or worked in front, clearing debris and tackling the larger branches with loppers and hand saws.

By noontime, we actually reached the end of the trail—something I honestly didn't think we'd accomplish in one session. Spirits were high, with comments ranging from "we are the super team" to "the elite team," and finally Phil's closing declaration: "We are legends in our own minds!"

In total, we cleared 0.4 miles of trail, contributing 14.25 volunteer hours valued at \$598.50. Lunch for the volunteers came to \$25.47.

And to this incredible crew—a super thanks for your hard work, good humor, and determination. Your willingness to show up, push through, and make a real difference on the trails is deeply appreciated. You truly are a legendary team.



On May 16th I attended the first-ever park friends' group meeting at the Wachusett Mountain Ski Resort in Princeton MA representing equestrians across the state.

I got the chance to have some good conversations with DCR Director of Partnerships Paul Fahey and DCR Stewardship Council Vice Chair Susan Smiley. I also met up with some old friends from various groups across the state.

We spent a couple hours discussing shared issues of stewardship, park management and working with DCR and its advocates, including the DCR Stewardship Council. It was good to get some updates and networking with others from across the state that all have the same goal, improving our state forest and parks. BK

I couldn't help but think, who in their right mind would head into the woods to have a baby? One of the volunteers asked if we had seen a movie based on exactly that premise. We hadn't - and with that, we continued on our way.

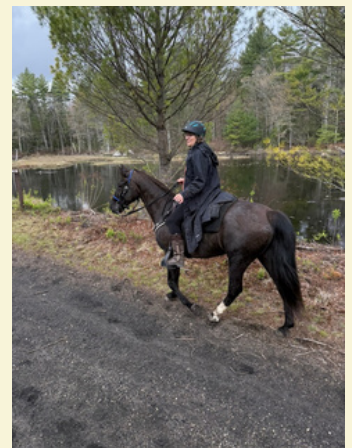

After giving the horses some well-deserved attention, they headed off, one asking where the next station was. All I said was, "You're headed in the right direction." No unfair advantages from us.

I was pleasantly surprised to hear peepers along the SNETT while we were riding. The birds were in full voice too, making the whole experience especially peaceful and enjoyable.

After the ride, we gathered for a delicious spread of pizzas and an impressive assortment of desserts - plus the best part, time spent with fellow riders.

Eagle Scout Project Groton MA

In April, we were contacted by Quinton Morse regarding his Eagle Scout project in Groton, MA. The project involved replacing a bridge in the Fritz & Helen Walker Conservation Area, an important trail resource that is open to horseback riders.

For his Eagle rank, Quinton was required to plan, develop, and execute the project largely on his own, with the Groton Trails Committee serving as his beneficiary organization and providing oversight and approval.

Quinton submitted his project presentation along with a request to BSTRA for material funding. After review, the Board approved his request, covering the cost of bridge materials totaling \$416.09.

I spent time working with Quinton via email, reviewing his bridge design and materials list. I framed my questions as learning opportunities so he could determine the correct solutions himself, mirroring the kind of problem-solving and documentation expected in a real-world project. I also offered guidance on strengthening both his presentation and his final report.

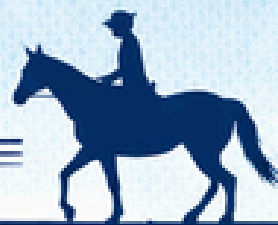

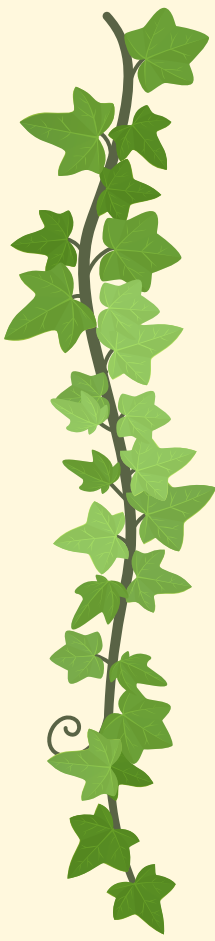


